

OVER THE PAST FEW WEEKS, I HAVE HAD A FEW ENQUIRES IN REGARDS TO THE CLUB PERMIT SCHEME, AND WHERE DOES THE CLUB STAND ON THIS ISSUE.

THE ANSWER TO THEIR ENQUIRES WAS THAT I WAS ALL FOR THIS SCHEME AND THAT I WOULD RAISE THE ISSUE AT THE NEXT COMMITTEE MEETING, TO SEE WHAT THE COMMITTEES FEELINGS WERE.

THE COMMITTEE WERE IN FAVOUR OF PURSUING THIS ISSUE IF THERE WAS ENOUGH INTEREST AMONGST THE MEMBERS,

Q: WHAT IS THE CLUB PERMIT SCHEME YOU ASK?

A: THE CLUB PERMIT SCHEME IS A PERMIT FOR RESTRICTED USE OF AN UNREGISTERED VEHICLE,

FOR EXAMPLE: YOU OWN A CONCOURSE P76, WHICH YOU INTEND ON KEEPING FOR THE SOLE PURPOSE OF DISPLAYING IT AT VARIOUS CAR SHOWS AND THE VEHICLE IN QUESTION IS NOT REQUIRED FOR YOUR DAY TO DAY TRANSPORT.

THE VEHICLE IN QUESTION COULD THEN BE A GOOD CANDIDATE FOR THIS SCHEME

Q: WHAT ARE THE BENEFITS OF THE CLUB PERMIT SCHEME?

A: THE CLUB PERMIT SCHEME IS A COST EFFECTIVE ALTERNATIVE TO FULL ROAD REGISTRATION

Q: WHAT ARE THE LIMITATIONS WITH THIS PERMIT I HERE YOU ASK?

A: THIS PERMIT IS <u>NOT</u> CHEAP REGO FOR OLD CARS, THEREFOR YOU ARE LIMITED TO USING THE VEHICLE IN QUESTION FOR AUTHORISED CLUB EVENTS ONLY FOR EXAMPLE: YOU MAY USE THE VEHICLE IN QUESTION FOR THE PURPOSE OF TRAVELLING TO ANY AUTHORISED EVENT LISTED IN THE CAR CLUB MAG (eg CONCOURSE, CAR DISPLAYS, CLUB MEETINGS).

THE VEHICLE IN QUESTION CANNOT BE USED FOR PROFIT OR GAIN

Q: I AM HAPPY WITH WHAT I HAVE READ. HOW DO I KNOW IF MY VEHICLE ELIGIBLE?

A: THE ANSWER TO THIS QUESTION IS SIMPLE,

1: THE VEHICLE MUST BE 25 YEARS OF AGE.

2: MUST BE ROADWORTHY.

3: BASICALLY UNMODIFIED.

4: MUST BE IN A PRESENTABLE CONDITION.

Q: I AM HAPPY WITH THE CONDITIONS AND CONFIDENT THAT MY CAR MEETS THE REQUIREMENTS. WHAT DO I DO NOW?

A: THE OBJECT OF THIS ARTICLE IS TO SEE HOW MANY PEOPLE IN OUR CLUB ARE INTERESTED IN THIS SCHEME. FOR OUR CLUB TO BE ABLE TO OFFER THIS SCHEME. THE CLUB IS REQUIRED TO PUT TOGETHER A SUBMISSION FOR VIC ROADS. ONE OF THE QUESTIONS IS HOW MANY MEMBERS WOULD LIKE TO TAKE ADVANTAGE OF THIS SCHEME.
