P-76 Ivan Washington

Let me introduce myself, I am a retired V.A.C.C Auto Engineer who has never owned a P-76 before.

I was looking for a car that would tow my caravan and I spied a "for sale" on a 100,000 Klm V8 Executive auto which looked like new inside with the exterior showing a few rust spots only,in what I was told were the usual places.

A test-drive showed a few solvable problems only so I bought it. First impressions were (A) it handled and cornered much better than I had expected and would eat a Holden or Falcon (B) it overheated and wouldn't pull the skin off a rice pudding. First move was to join the Leyland P-76 owners club and I then had a chat to Robert Zsidai.

Cleaning the radiator and fitting a new thermostat stopped the instant boiling but the engine still ran too hot on the after market Smiths gauge (which tested as accurate) and boiled when pulling a trailer up a hill.

A previous owner had fitted twin electric fans in the front of the core as well as a coarse pitch engine fan.

First I removed the electric fans and mounting bars.

Measurement of the fans ect and calculation of their total area showed that the fan assembles covered 43% of the radiator core area

Next, on Robert's advice, I moved the number plate to one side and cut a3" by 15" hole in the lower body panels to admit air to the radiator lower core.

I then fabricated a small scoop or spoiler to fit under the bumper to direct air into the new air hole.

This was a big improvement but the car still wouldn't pull like a 4.4 V8 and overheated with the fan on .

By this time I had noticed that the exhaust system was obviously not original and looked like one made up in an exhaust shop with the usual pipe bending machine that caves in the inside of the bend. The two engine pipes measured 1 5/8"(41mm) O.D and the rest of the system 2".

Too small, it got worse.

After removing the system I found that a short piece 1 ½" OO pipe had been stuffed into the flange (to locate a sealing ring) and this smaller pipe still had the burrs from the angle grinder cut off wheel restricting the hole further.

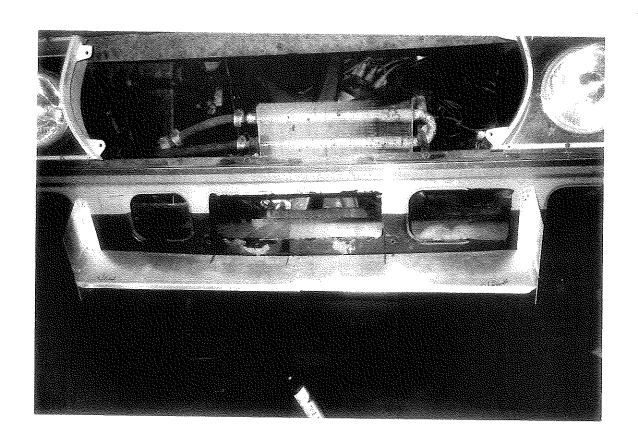
I made up new flanges and outlet pipes using 1 3/4" (45mm) mandrel bends that matched the manifold outlet holes, fed them into a 2" pipes which collected into a 2 1/4" system.

Result, it runs all day on the thermostat at 180 Deg F accelerates and goes up hills like they don't exist and uses less fuel.

Whilst the overall combination of suspension, brake and steering on my Peugeot 505 E.T.I is superior (and that applies to most cars) I love driving it and hope to bring it down to Melbourne for a club outing one day.
