IT THEN BECAME APPARENT, THAT ALL OF THE OTHER DRIVERS WITH FUEL PROBLEMS HAD EXACTLY THE SAME GLUGY RESIDUE IN THEIR FILTERS.

THEN IT HIT US, IN ALL CASES, ALL THE CARS WERE RUNING THE SAME BRAND OF A NEW HIGH OCTAIN, LEAD REPLACMENT FUEL AND SURPRISINGLY, ALL OF US HAD PERCHASED THE FUEL AT DIFFERENT SERVICE STATIONS AROUND THE STATE.
